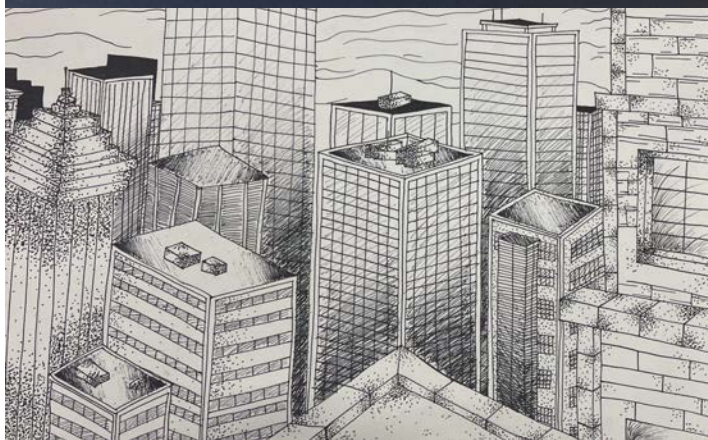
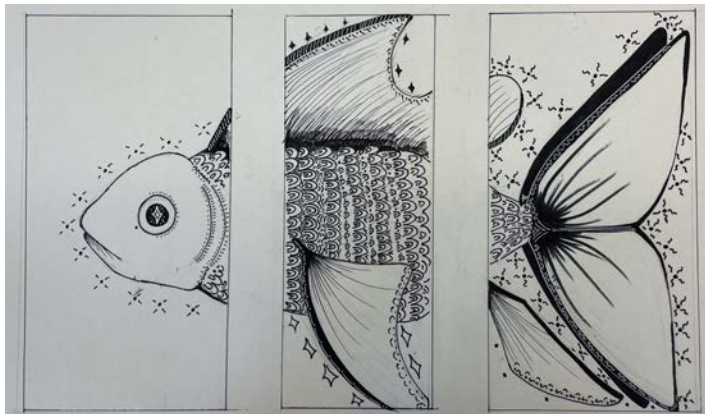

We talked with students about important aspects of being a high school student and ways to access support when needed. All students took a survey to share what they are looking to gain more information about and the counselors will be incorporating this feedback into the lessons and programs that we develop. We are excited to have the opportunity to facilitate lessons throughout the semester and get to know our ninth grade students!

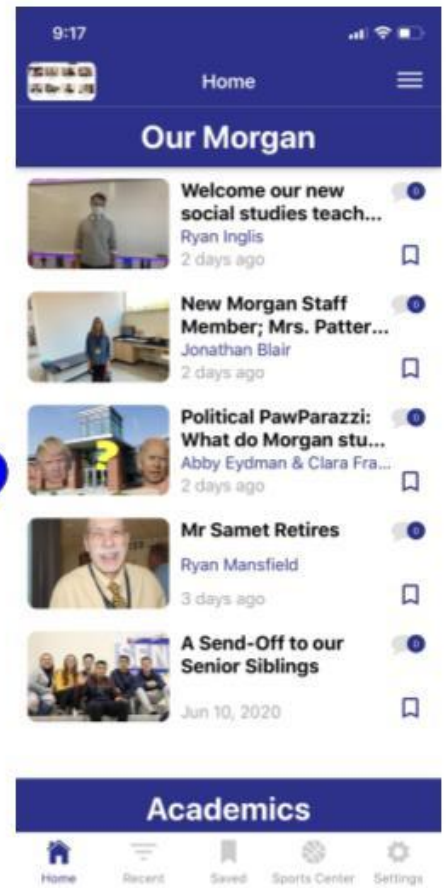
