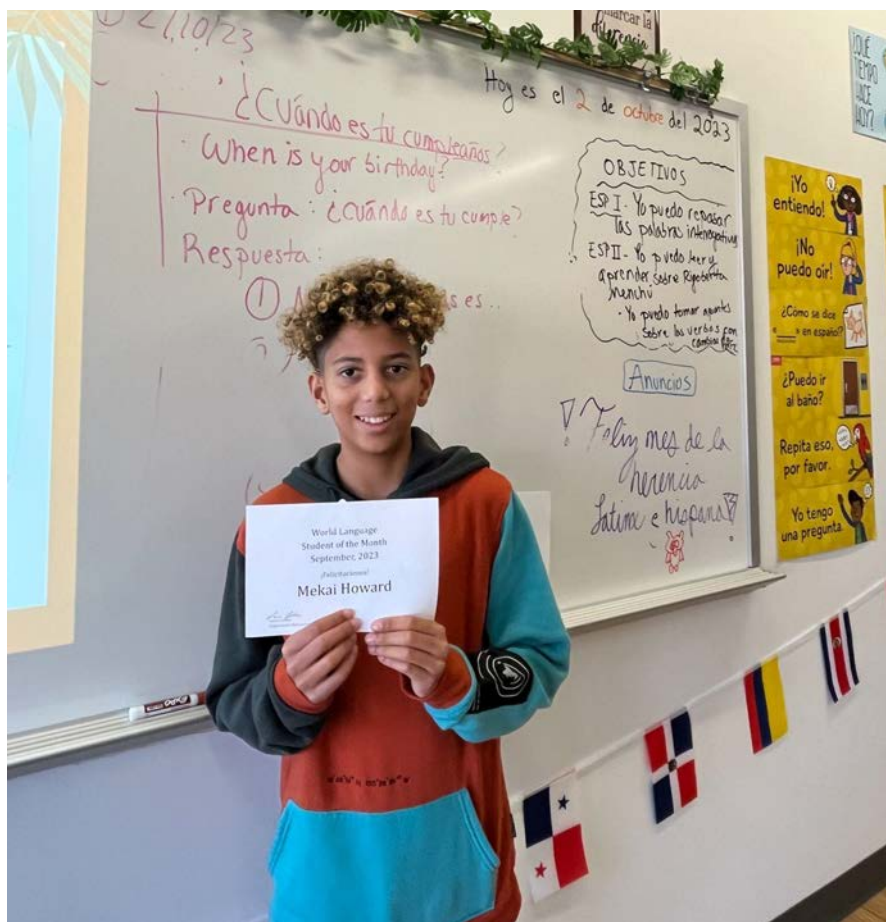
SCHOOL PHOTOS

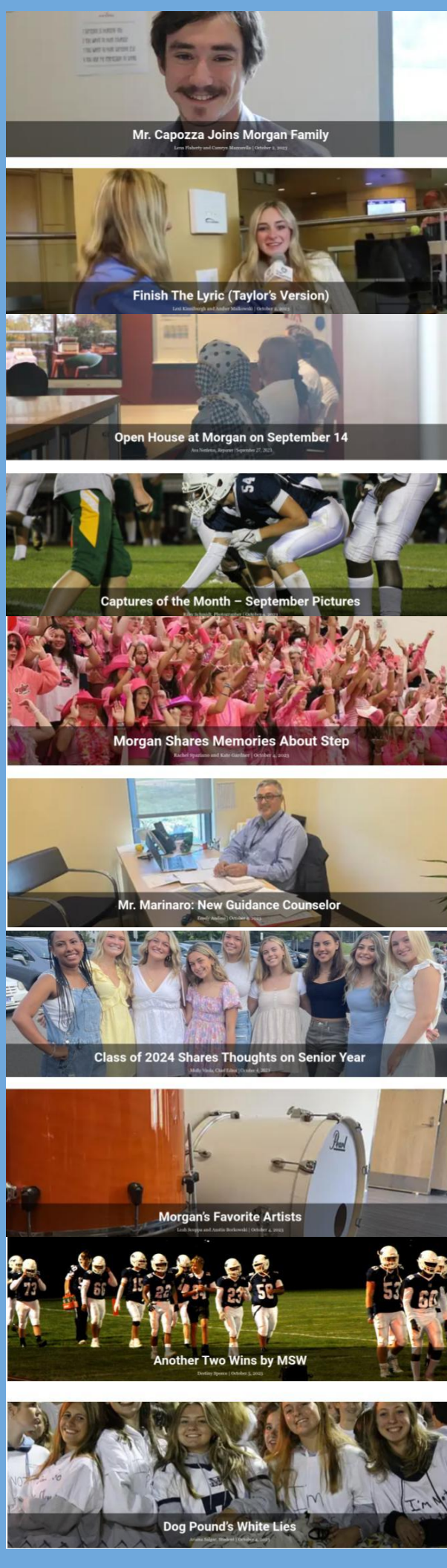
