WACE-NATIONAL CO-OP SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - Sixteenth Annual scholarship program will award 175 merit co-op scholarships to students who plan to participate in college cooperative education at one of the Partner Institutions. 17. EILEEN KRAUS SCHOLARSHIP - Female students currently residing in Connecticut are invited to apply for this scholarship and must be able to attend the Connecticut Women's Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony in Hartford, CT for the Annual Induction Ceremony in November 2019. **DEADLINE: February 15, 2019**

18. BOHDAN KOLINSKY MEMORIAL SPORT JOURNALISM SCHOLARSHIP - Honoring the memory of Bohdan Kolinsky, longtime school sports editor of the Hartford Courant, this scholarship provides \$2,500 to a secondary school senior from Connecticut who is admitted to an accredited four-year college for study leading to a career in sports journalism. **DEADLINE February 22, 2019.**

19. 100 YEARS OF WOMEN SCHOLARSHIP AWARD - This scholarship is for a senior planning to enroll in the University of Connecticut and who have demonstrated a commitment to women's issues through service to their community or school. The scholarship ranges up to \$1,000. **DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 28, 2019**

20. VIRGINIA R. ROLLEFSON ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP - Awarded to a student residing in the Lower Connecticut River Valley who has demonstrated leadership and initiative in promoting conservation, preservation, restoration, or environmental education. **DEADLINE: March 1, 2019**
