IF YOU NEED A TRANSCRIPT FOR YOUR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION YOU MUST FILL OUT A TRANSCRIPT REQUEST FORM AT LEAST **10 DAYS BEFORE THE DUE DATE**. **MAIL COULD TAKE UP TO 5 DAYS TO REACH ITS DESTINATION.**

13. PFLAG HARTFORD AND HELEN AND BOB BRILL SCHOLARSHIP - This scholarship is open to any member of the LGBTQ community or Ally student who is active in school or the community concerning LGBTQ rights. **DEADLINE: MARCH 29, 2019**

14. UNITED STATES JUNIOR CHAMBER INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION - Each year the JCI awards \$1,000 grants to graduating high school seniors who plan to continue their education at accredited post-secondary institutions. The application is located on the web page <http://ctjcisenatefoundation.org>. **DEADLINE January 11, 2019**

15. CONNECTICUT NURSERYMEN'S FOUNDATION, INC. - The scholarship grant will be \$5,000 per year, renewable if the student maintains academic eligibility in college. Students must maintain a 3.0 grade point average (GPA). Students must be residents of the State of Connecticut, and may attend either in state or out of state institutions. The student must be a high school senior or currently enrolled at the college level, majoring in a horticulture related field. **DEADLINE: March 4, 2019**
