Students are responsible for following all rules on the applications, adhering to **DEADLINES**, and returning complete scholarship packages to the Mrs. Theiler for transcripts (if applicable) and mailing.

IF YOU NEED A TRANSCRIPT FOR YOUR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION YOU MUST FILL OUT A TRANSCRIPT REQUEST FORM AT LEAST **10 DAYS BEFORE THE DUE DATE**. **MAIL COULD TAKE UP TO 5 DAYS TO REACH ITS DESTINATION.**

47. BILL'S SEAFOOD SCHOLAR/ATHLETE SCHOLARSHIP - Two \$2,000 scholarships, one for a male and one for a female, who must have participated in sports all four years, good academic standing, good character, leadership qualities, good citizenship and intends to pursue an education in a four year college, junior college, business school, technical college or trade school are encouraged to apply. **DEADLINE: April 24, 2019**

48. FRIENDS OF MORGAN MUSIC - Two \$500 scholarships for a graduating senior who will be continuing their education in the field of performing arts or a related field (communication, television, music education, drama, voice, instrumental). Students must be involved in music or the performing arts. **DEADLINE: May 1, 2019**

49. THE RICHARD S. DART MEMORIAL ARTS SCHOLARSHIP - A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who will pursue an education in the ARTS (music, drama, dance, or visual art). You must present an audition in your chosen art form. This scholarship is available on line at The Morgan School and then to the Guidance web site under scholarship. **DEADLINE: April 26, 2019**

50. MIDDLESEX COUNTY BLUE STAR MOTHERS - To be awarded to a senior planning to attend a 4-year college and has a parent or legal guardian actively serving in the military or a parent who is an honorably discharged Veteran. Military Service includes the Army, Marines, Air Force, Navy, Coast Guard, National Guard and Reserves. **DEADLINE: May 1, 2019**

51. DELTA KAPPA GAMMA SOCIETY INTERNATIONAL - The Connecticut Chapter, Alpha Kappa State will award 4 cash grants to high school seniors planning to enter the following teacher education programs: The Elizabeth Sonier Grant awards \$750 to a senior planning to pursue a degree in Music Education. The Hannah Griswold Grant awards \$750 to a minority senior planning to major in Education. The Lee P. Formica Grant awards \$500 to a senior entering a teacher education program. The Margaret Rose Nielsen Grant awards \$500 to a senior planning to major in Math, Science, or Technology Education. **DEADLINE: APRIL 7, 2019**

52. DENNIS MALONE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - The Connecticut Parks Association is offering a scholarship, up to \$1,000.00, for a graduating senior who plans to attend an accredited 2 or 4 year college and pursue a career in park management, forestry, horticulture, agronomy or a closely related field. **DEADLINE" April 18, 2019**

53. AMERICAN ITALIAN WOMEN OF GREATER NEW HAVEN - A scholarship of \$750 are being offered to area students who are of Italian decent. This scholarship is for graduating seniors with a strong academic record and a need for financial assistance. **DEADLINE: June 1, 2019**
