THE CLINTON CHORAL SCHOLARSHIP - The disbanding Choral group has chosen to distribute their funds through The Morgan School 2019 Scholarship Program to a senior with a love of singing and music who will be attending college in the Fall of 2019 and meets the criteria. This \$1,300 scholarship will be awarded to a student who plans to continue his/her education in Music either as a minor or major program of study. Selection of the winner will be based on scholastic performance, music history & performance and acceptance to an accredited College or University. **DEADLINE TO GUIDANCE APRIL 23, 2019**

This is a \$500 award. You must be continuing your studies in education. See application for further information.
