IF YOU NEED A TRANSCRIPT FOR YOUR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION YOU MUST FILL OUT A TRANSCRIPT REQUEST FORM **10 DAYS BEFORE THE DUE DATE.** **MAIL COULD TAKE UP TO 5 DAYS TO REACH ITS DESTINATION.**

**68. ED HIDEK MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$300 scholarship for a graduating female senior who has been a member of any Morgan athletic team, who will be attending a two or four year college and has financial need. **DEADLINE: May 6, 2019**

**69. GUILFORD SPORTSMEN'S ASSOCIATION, INC.** - The conservation sciences area is broadly defined and encompasses any systematic body of knowledge regarding man's relationship to and utilization of his natural environment. Environmental branches of the biological, physical and social sciences, forestry, wildlife and fisheries management, marine biology, oceanography, environmental engineering, ecology, parks and recreational services would be considered "conservation sciences." If you are planning to further your education in any of these fields you should apply. **DEADLINE: May 15, 2019**

**The Brett Renfrew Memorial Scholarship** - The Brett Renfrew Scholarship Program has provided stipends for students who wish to follow a dream that will help foster their growth and development. Students have used the scholarship monies to defray college costs, to travel overseas, to enroll in a summer enrichment program, to develop an artistic talent, and to participate in any other activity that will allow them to pursue a personal goal. **DEADLINE: May 1, 2019**

**71. CLINTON EDUCATION FOUNDATION STUDENT GRANT PROGRAM -  
OPEN TO ALL MORGAN STUDENTS GRADES 9-12**

**William Calvert Student Grant** - Funds are available for students in the district with a financial need and who express a passion for the arts, academics, or athletics. Funds may be used to purchase musical instruments, sports equipment or books. **DEADLINE: May 1, 2019**

**72. THE PAUL MILLETTE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$1,000.00 scholarship to recognize a college bound graduating senior who has demonstrated ability in academics and has a financial need. A one-page essay is necessary. **DEADLINE: May 15, 2019**

**73. NEW ALLIANCE BANK/RICHARD S. DART SCHOLARSHIP** - A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior based on academic achievement, financial need, and who has indicated a preference for a future career in banking/finance or business. **DEADLINE: MAY 15, 2019**
