74. **ROBERT BRIGOCKUS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - In memory of Mr. Robert Brigockus who served in many roles during his tenure at The Morgan School such as Teacher, Athletic Director and Coach. This \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded to one male and one female graduating senior who plans to attend a 2 or 4-year college/university or technical school. Students of all grade point averages are strongly encouraged to apply. Financial need will also be a consideration. **DEADLINE: May 10, 2019**

75. **PATRICIA SIDAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** - The Patricia Gayer Sidas, in honor of her mother, Helen Gayer who was a graduate of The Morgan School Class of 1938, and a cook at The Pierson School for many years. This \$2,500 award is to provide assistance to Morgan students who plan to attend a 2 or 4-year college/university or technical school and pursue a career in the fields of technology, culinary or business. Funds may be used to purchase tangible items needed to pursue the career of choice. For example, items such as tools, utensils, books, etc. Students of all grade point averages are strongly encouraged to apply. Financial need will also be a consideration. **DEADLINE: May 10, 2019**

76. **VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS (VFW)** - Since 1947, the Voice of Democracy has been the VFW's premier scholarship program. Each year, nearly 40,000 high school students compete for more than \$2 million in scholarships and incentives. Students compete by writing and recording an audio essay on an annual patriotic theme. The year's theme is What Makes America Great. **DEADLINE: 10/31/2019**

77. CLINTON ART SOCIETY - The Clinton Art Society was founded in 1949 by a small group of professional artists dedicated to expanding and enriching the arts on the Connecticut Shoreline. This \$500 award is open to graduating seniors who plan to pursue a degree in Visual Arts or Arts Management.

DEADLINE: May 31, 2019

78. DOWD SCHOLARSHIP - Established by Charlotte B. Dowd to provide funds to defer the cost of higher education. Will be awarded to a graduating student(s) who has achieved scholastic success, leadership, character, and good citizenship at school and in the community. An essay of 150 word is required.

DEADLINE: May 13, 2019

79. LIBERTY BANK/DONALD B. WILBUR SCHOLARSHIP - A 1,000 dollar scholarship for graduating senior who will be enrolled full-time at a two-four year institution of higher education with the goal to major in engineering or a technology related field.

DEADLINE: May 24, 2019
